Program Description	If you are a faculty member, we will repay your loan. In return, you serve at an eligible health professions school.

Tax Liability	We tax the full loan repayment award. You may receive a tax liability benefit equal to 39 percent of the loan repayment amount.

Eligibility Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • U.S. citizen (born or naturalized), U.S. national, or lawful permanent resident • You come from a disadvantaged background. We base this on environmental and economic factors. • You are a faculty member at an approved health professions school. You must have a contract for two years or more.
